THE WAR.

IN the following list we reprint, with many additions, the names of all Old Westminsters known to be serving in the Navy or the Army in the present War. This list, which supersedes those previously published in the ELIZABETHAN, has been corrected up to about the middle of February, and it is hoped that, so far as it goes, it may prove accurate and reliable. At the same time the compilers are conscious of the fact that there are probably many omissions and almost inevitable mistakes. Especially is this the case with regard to those

on active service. These, where it is known to be a fact that they are at the front, have been distinguished by an asterisk, but there are probably many more, especially Officers in the Indian Army, who ought thus to be designated but of whom the compilers have no certain information.
