Entries which have no date appended have been derived from various sources, including the Roll of Service compiled by the Entertainments Committee of the Elizabethan Club. The Editors have to thank the Committee for their kind permission to use this valuable material.

The Editors wish to thank numerous correspondents who have sent in corrections or additions to the previous number and to appeal to past and present Westminsters to assist in making the list more complete and accurate by sending them information, including even approximate dates of gazetting which may greatly shorten the labour of searching for an entry in the *Gazette*.
