The following list of Westminsters serving in H.M.'s Forces has been compiled by the Editors of the Record of Old Westminsters. It follows the plan of the two previous numbers, except for two changes in the section dealing with the Army, where the automatic promotion of Second Lieutenants to War Substantive Lieutenants, which now takes place at the end of six months' service, has not been noted, and promotion to temporary or acting rank of Captain, or higher, has been added after the last entry recorded from the *Gazette*, instead of being substituted for it. The first change has been dictated by the need to save the labour involved in making a very large number of alterations in the type, and the second will add much to the value of the Roll as a basis for the preparation of the next edition of the Record.

The Editors have to repeat the acknowledgments expressed in the previous numbers for the help which they have received, and to add their thanks to the Committee of the Elizabethan Club for paying the cost of the publication. The Editors again appeal to past and present Westminsters to assist in making the list more complete and accurate by sending them information, including even approximate dates of gazetting which may greatly shorten the labour of searching for an entry in the *Gazette*.
